DATA PROTECTION (GDPR)

- Registration Forms (personal & medical information)
- Photographs / videos
- Observational notes
- Safeguarding concerns

To comply with the legislation Hyndburn Comets Majorettes will:

- Update, archive or securely delete enrolment information every 2 years – unless agreed with the member to use photography/videos for the website, social media or newspapers.
- Not use personal data for marketing or research purposes
- Not share personal data unless parental / guardian consent is given
